#### **Specific Steps of Routine:**

- 1. Open the book
- 2. Read each page/talk about each picture on the page
- 3. Turn the page

### Words I will use with my child:

Word Type	Example	Words that I will use with my child during the routine/activity
Names (nouns)	tree, cat, mom	book, page, bear, quack
Location	up, down, under	on
Actions (verbs)	open, eat, run	open, turn, see
Social words	hi, bye, night-night	hí, bye
Describing words	red, big, all gone	yellow, red, brown, green
Words that express belonging	my, daddy's	my, mommy's, daddy's

## Tiny Tips I will use during the routine/activity:

- 1. Expand on what child says...when child says, "bird" I will say, "red bird" or "I see red bird"
- 2. Give specific praise...instead of saying, "good job", I will be more specific by saying, "I like how you used all your words"
